Training in Supervision/reflective practice - a minimum of 70 hours	Outline of training accompanied by certificates
Post qualification experience - a minimum of 30 hours of providing supervision	Log documenting at least 30 hours experience of providing supervision
APSE Code of Conduct	Signed copy of APSE Code of Conduct
Professional Indemnity Insurance	Copy of certificate covering supervisory work

Receiving supervision minimum of 1 hr for every 8 hrs of supervision provided, outside of line management.	Log documenting supervision for supervision. Report from Supervisor. Verbatim report or case study. Evaluation by supervisee/s.
