



THE 4-star [Golden Jubilee Hotel and Conference Centre](#) is set on the banks of the River Clyde and was voted Scotland's conference hotel of the year in 2020. It is on Beardmore Street, Clydebank, Glasgow

G81 4SA, and on the same campus as the NHS Golden Jubilee Hospital. The profits from the hotel and conference centre support the work of the hospital.



The hotel facilities will be available to APSE delegates and include a large car park, beautiful grounds, a pool, spa, gym and free Wifi.

With [Loch Lomond and the Trossachs National Park](#) just 20 minutes away, there is an opportunity to combine the conference with some holiday days in this beautiful part of Scotland.



And [Ayrshire and Arran](#) on the west coast of Scotland, are only a 40-minute drive from Glasgow.

Tuesday, June 14th, 2022: Registration from 11.30am.
Wednesday, June 15th: Conference closes after lunch.

Booking information:-

The cost for delegates is £200 for a residential stay— but there will be an **EARLY BIRD OFFER of £175 if booked before Monday 7th March, 2022.** This includes lunch on Day 1 with evening meal, bed and breakfast, and lunch on Day 2.

The day rate delegate cost is £120, with an **EARLY BIRD OFFER of £100.** This includes lunch on Day 1, evening meal and lunch on Day 2.

Guests: If delegates are bringing guests who are not attending the conference there is an extra charge of £30 for bed and breakfast, plus £60 for meals (lunch on arrival, evening meal and lunch on the second day).

Extra nights: The Golden Jubilee Hotel and Conference Centre is willing to book extra nights for delegates, either before the event or afterwards. This would need to be processed direct with the Golden Jubilee Hotel and Conference Centre, rather than through APSE.

Getting there

By air

From Glasgow Airport—the hotel runs a free courtesy pick-up and drop-off service. This can be booked direct with the hotel. Telephone 0141 951 6000. A Glasgow Airport taxi from the airport will cost approx. £25.

By rail

The nearest train station is Dalmuir (0.4 miles walk or taxi).

Take a train from either Glasgow Queen Street or Glasgow Central Station to Dalmuir Station. There are approximately 11 trains per hour. Direct trains also run between Dalmuir and Edinburgh Waverley and if you are travelling from London, the Caledonian Sleeper runs nightly. Dalmuir station is a 10-minute walk from the hotel. By car

The hotel is easily accessed from the M8, junction 30, west of Glasgow - see map on the hotel website. For satnavs use the postcode: G81 4SA.

By bus

From Glasgow city centre you can take the First Glasgow bus service numbers 1, 1A, 1B, 1D. These services all travel along Dumbarton Road and the stop for the hotel is at the end of Beardmore Street. Journey approx. 45 minutes.
