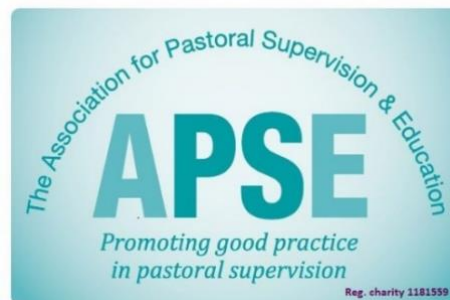

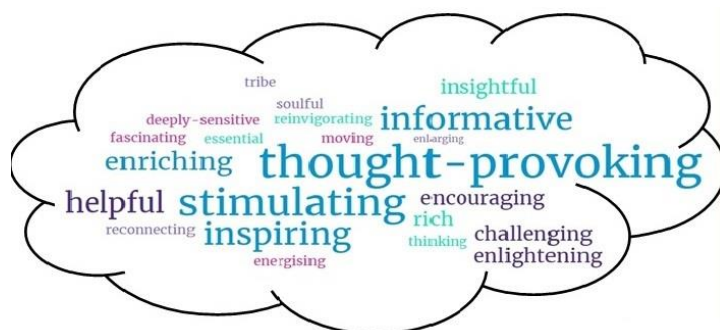
WE AIM to promote high standards of pastoral supervision by:
